



# Forest Park High School Bruin Band Boosters

## *Volunteer Descriptions*

### Home Games

- Uniform
  - Assist with uniforms and hats in uniform room
  - Assist with plumes before band marches to field
  - Take scrubs to field
  - During games, collect plumes before the band sits, pass out scrubs
  - Collect scrubs, pass out plumes before halftime show, collect plumes after halftime show
  - After game, help put uniforms back into closets
  - Return ID badges to Volunteer Coordinator or designated alternate
- Seat Covers / Water
  - Fill coolers with water, take to field along with cups, towels and seat covers
  - Put seat covers on seats at stadium
  - Fill cups with water for section leaders to hand out to band members
  - After game, collect seat covers and coolers
  - In the event of rain, the seat covers need to be wiped down with towels and may need to be laid out inside
  - Empty coolers
  - Return coolers and covers to uniform room
  - Return ID badges to Volunteer Coordinator or designated alternate
- Third Quarter Concessions
  - Goes to side door of concessions stand at the end of the half time show. Takes orders and money from our band students, coordinating with those working in the concessions stand. This is a privilege to our band students so that they do not have to wait to be served with the general population
  - Students are allowed to purchase **ONLY** uniform friendly snacks:
    - Only clear liquids may be consumed when in uniform
    - No condiments on any food items (ketchup, mustard, etc)
    - No pizza, popcorn, nachos or chocolate – drinks or candy
- Guard Parent
  - Assists guard students with flags, other equipment, and other needs as necessary
- Pit Crew
  - Transports all required pit instruments to the football field prior to pre-game
  - Transports all required pit instruments onto the field prior to the halftime show
  - Transports all required pit instruments back to the high school after the game
  - Return ID badges to Pit Coordinator or designated alternate

### Away Games

- Chaperone
  - Note: Chaperones for away games and competitions act as uniform helpers and travel on the buses with the students
  - Assist with uniforms and hats in uniform room
  - Hand out scrubs before students board buses

  - Travel with students on buses
  - Sit near students in stands
  - When students are allowed to go to concessions, stay near them to monitor behavior and purchases
  - Travel back with students on buses
  - After game, help put uniforms back into closets
  - Return ID badges to Volunteer Coordinator or designated alternate
- Seat Covers / Water
  - Fill coolers with water
  - Ensure personal travel in your own vehicle (car pool is a good idea) to the away game location with the seat covers, cups and water jugs
  - Put seat covers on seats at stadium
  - Fill cups with water for section leaders to hand out to band members
  - After game, collect seat covers and coolers
  - In the event of rain, the seat covers need to be wiped down with towels and may need to be laid out inside
  - Empty coolers
  - Return coolers and covers to uniform room / band room
  - Return ID badges to Volunteer Coordinator or designated alternate
- Guard Parent
  - Assists guard students with flags, other equipment, and other needs as necessary
- Pit Crew
  - Load all required pit instruments, oversized band instruments, color guard equipment onto the trailer
  - Provide own transportation to the away game location
  - Unload the trailer
  - Transport all required pit instruments to the football field prior to pre-game
  - Transport all required pit instruments onto the field prior to the halftime show
  - Transport all required pit instruments back to the trailer after the game
  - Load all required pit instruments, oversized band instruments, color guard equipment onto the trailer
  - Unload the trailer and return all equipment and instruments to the band room
  - Return ID badges to Pit Coordinator or designated alternate

### Competitions

- Chaperone
  - Note: Chaperones for away games and competitions act as uniform helpers and travel on the buses with the students
  - Assist with uniforms and hats in uniform room
  - Hand out scrubs before students board buses
  - Place bus number placard onto bus window
  - Ensure plume boxes, podium skirt, scrubs bag, water and first aid kit are loaded on the bus
  - Travel with students on buses
  - Stay with the band through warm up
  - Retrieve the scrubs and “plume” the students
  - Walk with the band to the stadium and enjoy the show
  - Immediately leave the stands after the band performs and walk with the band to their rally point; collect the plumes and pass out scrubs
  - Sit near students in stands
  - When students are allowed to go to concessions, stay near them to monitor behavior and purchases
  - Travel back with students on buses
  - Upon return to the high school, help put uniforms back into closets
  - Return ID badges to Volunteer Coordinator or designated alternate
- Guard Parent
  - Assists guard students with flags, other equipment, and other needs as necessary
- Pit Crew
  - Load all required pit instruments, oversized band instruments, color guard equipment onto the trailer
  - Provide own transportation to the away game location
  - Unload the trailer
  - Transport all required pit instruments to the football field prior to pre-game
  - Transport all required pit instruments onto the field prior to the halftime show
  - Transport all required pit instruments back to the trailer after the game
  - Load all required pit instruments, oversized band instruments, color guard equipment onto the trailer
  - Unload the trailer and return all equipment and instruments to the band room
  - Return ID badges to Pit Coordinator or designated alternate

### Pants Washing

- Uniform pants will be washed at the discretion of the Uniform Mom
- NO BLEACH is to be used when you wash uniform pants
- You will receive written instructions when you volunteer to wash pants

### Scrubs Washing

- Scrubs need washing after every game or competition
- There are no special instructions for washing scrubs (bleach is safe to use on the scrubs)
- Scrubs are worn to protect our white, white, white pants
